Overview:

Staffing:

The facility has both male and female staffers on duty.

The facility is managed by the on-duty dispatcher / jailer and the agency's 2-3 on duty law enforcement officers.

The jail administration reports that the staff level and framework is sufficient, given the current operation.

On duty law enforcement officers will assist with general jail work, cell checks, and other duties.

On a routine day, the jail will have all 7 jail slots staffed.

Healthcare:

Currently, the jail has a nurse who is usually on site at least once a day.

The Review Committee urges the City to assess the current health care plan, in terms of staffing levels, on site times, and like facets.

Inmate Status Patterns:

On a routine day:

The site will house some 25 inmates, with a local misdemeanor/low risk status.

The site will house some 6 inmates, with a probation / parole hold status.

Physical Plant Updates:

It appears that the site camera system, is in need of an update.

The staff is working to update select plumbing fixtures, HVAC systems, general physical plant updates, and like features.

The Jail has a new dishwasher.

General Matters:

The staff is working to review and update the agency food plan.

The staff is working to update "booking" forms. The staff is working to update SCBA postings / protocols.

The staff is working to update the inmate medicine security settings.

The staff is working to update the "rights" posting.

The site administrator completed the Jail Administrator Course as hosted by the Arkansas Law Enforcement Training Academy (Spring of 2022).

Conclusion:

The Review Committee applauds the Mayor, City Officials, and City Employees as they serve the community. The professional staff oversees a clean and orderly facility.

The Review Committee wishes the best for Mayor Wilson as she prepares to retire. She has well served the community.
